The Song He Yuan at Springvale Necropolis has been designed in accordance with Feng Shui principles and a Feng Shui Master provided advice regarding the cemetery design.

The project recently went through its second stage of development which included Sesame Grey Granite step treads & risers with an exfoliated finish. 150m² of Sesame Grey granite setts were laid in a stack bond pattern at the threshold to what is to be the Temple.

Paul Trotter & Associates P/L carried out the stone installation works meticulously.

Granite is fast becoming the choice of architects when large public works require pleasing aesthetics combined with exceptional durability.
